

DRIVEWAYS

PURPOSE

[the purpose/reason for the policy]

POLICY STATEMENT

1. The onus for provision of an entrance or driveway remains with the relevant property owner.
2. The position of any entrance or driveway in any road reserve shall be as approved by the Chief Executive Officer.
3. Council will undertake to form, rubble and/or bituminise any driveway from the road edge to the property boundary provided the full quoted cost of the work is paid by the relevant property owner before any work is carried out.
4. Alternative pavement surfacing for driveways e.g. concrete, brick pavers etc., is permissible and can be approved but will not be constructed by Council.
5. If, as the result of any alteration in levels or alignment of a roadway affecting an entrance or driveway, the entrance or driveway will be reinstated at Council's expense.
6. Council will reconstruct existing asphalt driveways in block paving at nil cost to the property owner, where the driveway/verge does not exceed 4.5m in depth.
7. Where the driveway/verge exceeds 4.5m in depth, then the cost of additional block paving work is to be met by the owner. The additional works can be coordinated and arranged through Council's paving contract at the current competitive contract rate.
