To ensure availability of the vaccines listed below, payment is required at least five (5) working days prior to attending a clinic. Payment can be made at the City of Mitcham, 131 Belair Road, Torrens Park.	
Hepatitis A and B Full course = 3 doses	Adult \$97.00 per dose (includes GST) Child \$61.20 per dose
Hepatitis B Full course = 3 doses	Adult \$24.10 per dose (includes GST) Child \$13.90 per dose
Hepatitis A Full course = 2 doses	Adult \$84.00 per dose (includes GST) Child \$53.50 per dose
Varicella (Chicken Pox) Full course = 1 dose (children), 2 doses (adults)	\$68.60 per dose (includes GST)
Influenza Quadrivalent Vaccine	\$25.00 per dose

**Boostrix – Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping Cough** vaccine is available at the community clinics at a cost of \$40.30 per dose – Credit card payment only accepted.
