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COMMUNITY WELLBEING FEE SUMMARY 2020 / 2021

To receive the subsidised co-contribution rate residents must meet the eligibility criteria for SA Home & Community Care (SA HACC) funding, or have an appropriate Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) 'My Aged Care' referral.

Some Community Wellbeing programs are only available to CHSP & SA HACC subsidised clients. If a program is open to all residents (space allowing) the non-subsidised contribution rate is listed below.

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

Social Groups – Community Wellbeing Facilitated

Up to 3 hours of staff led activities, which include full morning or afternoon tea. Examples are Tuesday Social Group at Cumberland Community Centre, Friday Social Group at Blackwood Community Centre, Cumby Crew, Colour Group, etc.

Note: Some classes may incur additional material fees (to be quoted).

Subsidised co-contribution	\$ 5	Per attendance
Non-subsidised contribution (if places available)	\$ 7	Per attendance

Social Groups – Community Led at Community Centres

Includes light morning or afternoon tea. Examples are Community Walking Group, Knitting Group, Conversation Group, Cards or Games Groups, etc.

Subsidised co-contribution	\$ 2	Per attendance
Non-subsidised contribution	\$ 2	Per attendance

'Out and About' Activities

Half-day excursions with a small group on the 'People Mover' Vehicle. Any entrance fees are at own cost.

Subsidised co-contribution	\$ 15	Per attendance
Non-subsidised contribution (if places available)	\$ 20	Per attendance

Community Bus Day Trips & Outings

Full day excursions, includes Men's Lunch Groups. Entrance fees may be additional, quoted prior to trip.

Subsidised co-contribution (exc. meal)	\$ 20	Per attendance
Non-subsidised contribution (exc. meal, if places available)	\$ 25	Per attendance
Subsidised co-contribution (inc. meal)	\$ 41	Per attendance
Non-subsidised contribution (inc. meal, if places available)	\$ 52	Per attendance

Includes 2-course meal – bookings essential.

COMMUNITY TRANSPORT

Community Bus

Subsidised, HCP, or transport disadvantaged resident co-contribution	\$ 2	Per trip, each way
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Individual Transport - CHSP & SA HACC subsidised only

Subsidised co-contribution within Mitcham Council area	\$ 6	Per trip, each way
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Subsidised co-contribution outside Mitcham Council area	\$ 10	Per trip, each way
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Group Transport - up to 3 people per vehicle

Subsidised co-contribution within Mitcham Council area	\$ 4	Per trip, each way
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Subsidised co-contribution outside Mitcham Council area	\$ 7	Per trip, each way
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HOME CARE SERVICES – SOUTHERN CROSS CARE

In 2018 the City of Mitcham conducted a review of Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) services in response to ongoing reform and quality improvement in the aged and disability sectors. As a result, Council decided to outsource domestic assistance, home modifications, and home and garden maintenance. Following a thorough tender process Southern Cross Care was appointed to deliver these specific services. The current prices for services offered by Southern Cross Care are:

SERVICE TYPE	RATE	COMMENT
Domestic Assistance	\$ 8	Per session
Home Maintenance - basic	\$ 12	Per hour (1 hour minimum)
Home Maintenance - specialised	Up to 15% of cost	For specialised jobs, as assessed per job by Southern Cross Care. Minimum \$12 per hour
Dumping & Transportation - green	\$ 12	Per full ute load of green waste
Home Modifications	Up to 15% of cost	Assessed per job by Southern Cross Care

Services delivered to a person on a Home Care Package can be quoted at full cost recovery to the client's individualised Package budget. Please enquire with Community Wellbeing for further details and full costs.

For those residents who are ineligible for funding, attendance at Social Activities & Community Meals may be possible at a rate that is not subsidised depending on the program or activity type. Please enquire for availability of spaces.
