



Operating Projects



What we heard @ 2 February DIG

What types of projects?



- Once-off expenditure
- Contributes to strategic outcomes and/or
- Required by legislation / compliance
- Do not require ongoing expenditure

E.g. studies, plans, reviews, events, elections, policy

The common reality...



\$200,000

E.g. legislated, required to effectively run operations and/or maintains service delivery.

\$231,000

E.g. contributes to strategic aims, often with direct benefits to the community.
