Exercise of the interment right

- Only the Interment Right Holder may exercise an interment right.
- If an interment right is held by more than 1 person, it may be exercised or enforced jointly or severally in accordance with section 35 of the Burial and Cremation Act 2013.

If the interment right holder is deceased, then the interment right must be transferred in accordance with Section 33 of the Burial and Cremation Act 2013 and by the eldest living relative of the deceased interment right holder in the following descending order of priority:

- (i) a child:
- (ii) a grandchild or great-grandchild;
- (iii) a brother or sister;
- (iv) a parent;
- (v) a grandparent;
- (vi) an aunt or uncle;
- (vii) a nephew or niece;
- (viii) a cousin;
- (ix) any other blood relative.

Transfer or renewal of the interment right

- The interment right may be transferred by the Interment Right Holder in accordance with the operating policies of the Authority and the Burial and Cremation Act 2013. The person to whom the interment right is transferred becomes the 'Interment Right Holder' from the date the transfer is registered by the Authority in the register of interment rights.
- The interment right may be renewed beyond the initial term at any time upon application of the Interment Right Holder and the relevant fees paid. For the relevant fees please refer to the City of Mitcham website under schedule of fees Mitcham Cemetery Fees

Person or persons to be interred / memorialised

 The Interment Right Holder has the right to determine who may be interred in or memorialised at the site as circumstances may require in accordance with the operating policies of the Authority and in accordance with the Burial and Cremation Act 2013.

Memorial - (Headstones and Plaques)

- Subject to the approval by the Authority, a memorial may be permitted at the site.
- The Interment Right Holder must engage the services of an authorised Monumental Mason to supply and install an approved headstone for a burial site.
- All memorials must be approved by the Authority before any work is initiated.

If the interment right is surrendered or expires

- The Interment Right Holder may surrender an unexercised interment right to the Authority. On its surrender the interment right is discharged.
- If an interment right expires, the Authority may re-use the interment site and remove any memorial on or at the interment site in accordance with the policies of the Authority and section 38 of the Burial and Cremation Act 2013.
