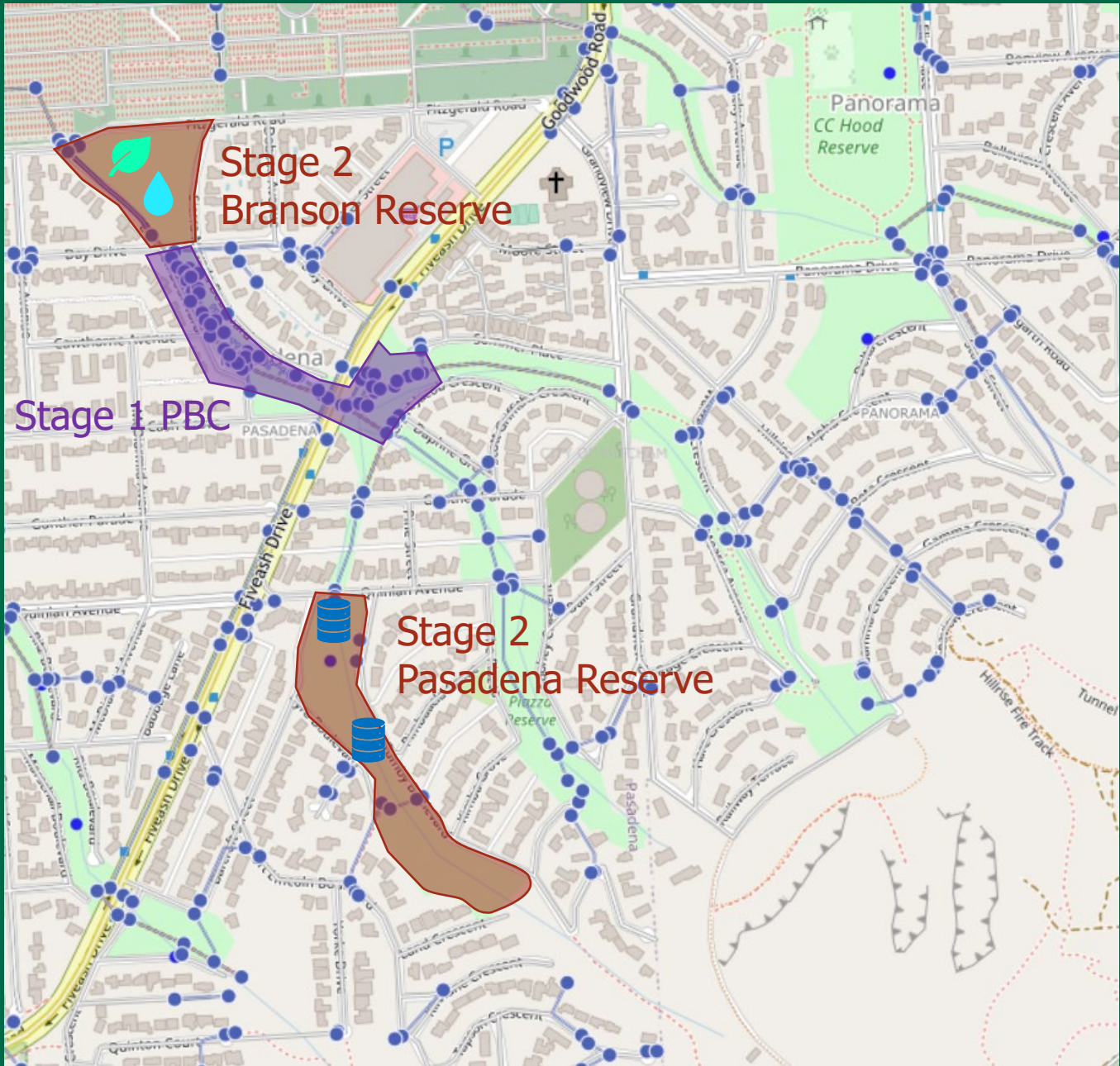

# Pasadena Smart Stormwater Project

- Successful DRF and Green Adelaide Grant Applications totalling \$2.3million
- DRF Grant agreement with SAFECOM being drafted
- Next Step - Council decision report coming soon:
  - Approval In Principle
  - Operational Cost Assessment
  - Placemaking opportunities



# Project Timeframe

- 3 year grant agreements – DRF and UoA to June 2027
- Design, Engagement and Construction and Planting – June 2024 – September 2026
- Evaluation of Risk Reduction and Project Co-benefits – September 2025 – December 2026
- Business Case and Dissemination of Findings – October 2025 – June 2027

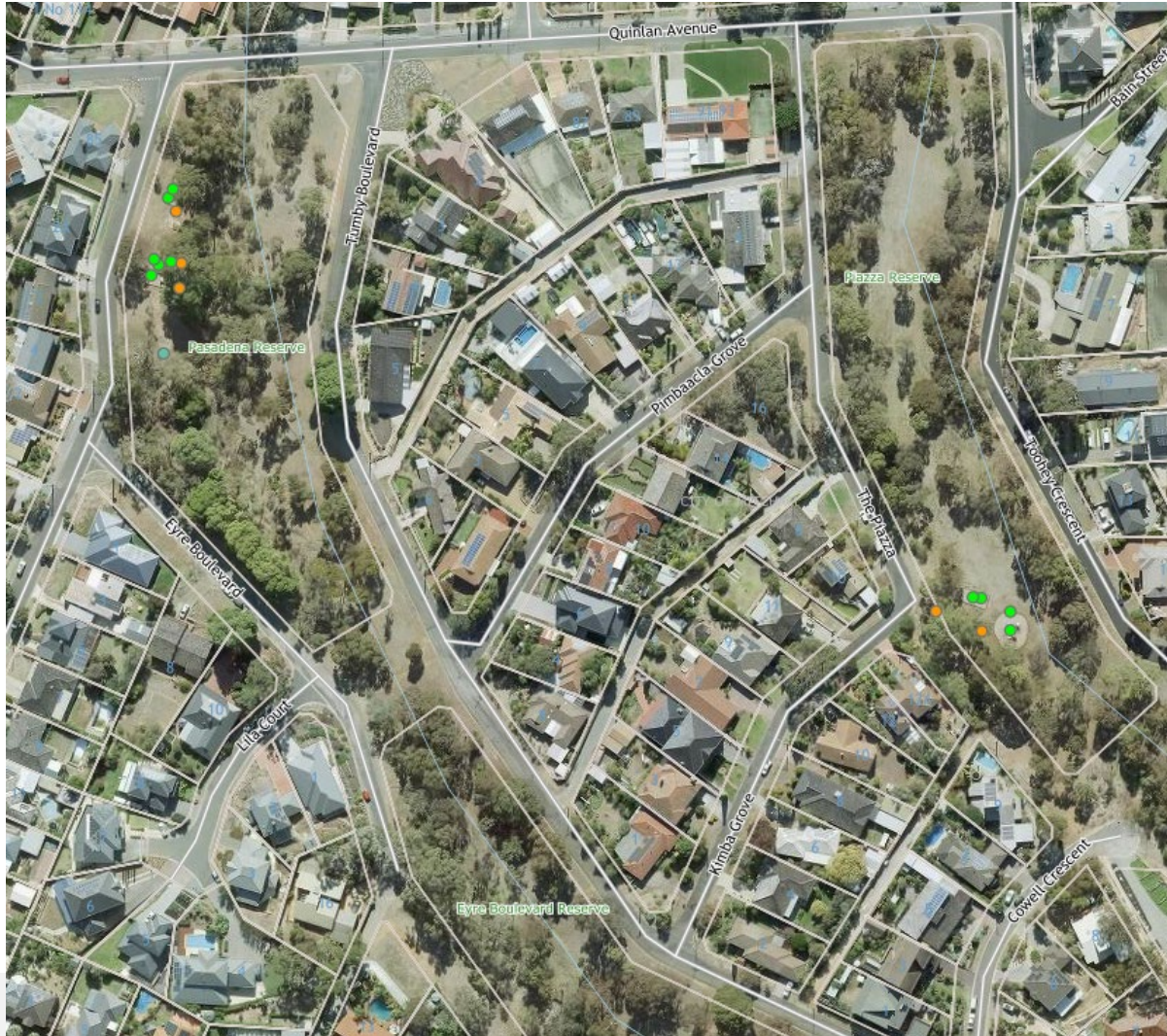
