Cut foliage and branches of larger woody weeds will be disposed of by the landholder. The contractor will neatly stack cut foliage and braches in small piles far away from buildings, fences, machinery, equipment and utilities (i.e. gas, electricity, water and telephone infrastructure). Weeds that are brushcut will not be gathered and stacked. The landholder is responsible for keeping people, livestock, and pets out of areas where chemical weed control has occurred during the recommended 'withholding' period for chemical(s).
