4 sessions over 2 weekends with community input into the CLMP & Cricket Club

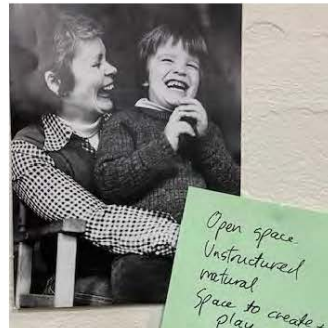

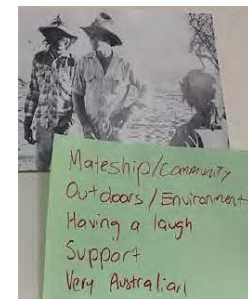
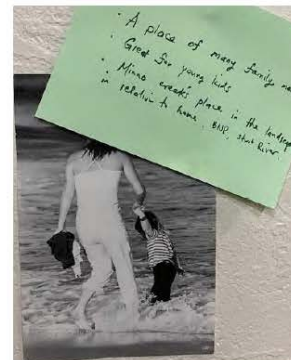
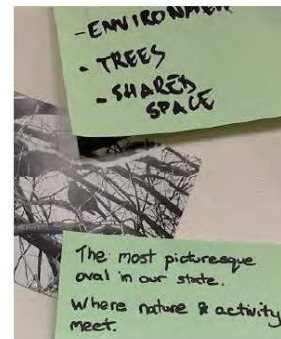
What do you value about Hawthorndene Oval / Apex Park
