





Summary


- Scale of the 'Backlog' significantly different now
- No longer 'linear backlog clearance'
- 'Backlog' has reached point of 'Natural Variation'
- Still need to Fully Fund Renewals (10Yr LTFP) as per AMPs & Service Levels
- Renewal timing (intervention) redistributed across LTFP
- Funding Options exist (0.42% 4yrs, 0.12% 10yrs...)
- Financial Options future consideration (next week)

% of Operating Revenue





% of Operating Revenue






Financial Liabilities — Adopted vs Draft

% of Operating Revenue







Consultation Environment

Lower response rates on citywide strategy consultations (not in your backyard)



- ABP responses:
 - 2023 **–** 212
 - 2022 **–** 47
 - 2021 **–** 20
 - 2020 114

Investing in additional consultation activities won't necessarily increase responses

- Consultation designed to meet legislative & policy requirements
- Additional low-cost techniques used to 'Inform' community

Proposed Consultation Approach

- One Draft ABP Document with one budget option modelled
 - Also include a 'Minimum' rate to deliver existing services and commitments (with this clearly explained upfront, but without financial modelling)
- Draft Summary Documents ABP and Four Year Delivery Plan
- Survey seeking feedback on:
 - Preference for Draft Budget or Minimum Budget
 - Support / opposition for individual new services & projects

Community can still provide their preference between a minimum budget or draft budget



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Survey Principles

2024/25 Annual Business Plan and Budget

- Preference for draft 2024/25 Annual Business Plan and Budget (including new services & projects) or Minimum budget.
- Support / Opposition for individual new services & projects

Four Year Delivery Plan

- Support / Opposition for individual new services & projects
- Nominate new services & projects as Council's top priorities in Years 2-4

Other New Services

 Support / Opposition for individual new services & projects considered by Council but not included in Years 1-4

Other

- Awareness of extensions, payment plans, deferral or rate capping
- Any other feedback / files
