**Objective**

Council’s Civic Participation and Leadership Award acknowledges and celebrates students who have demonstrated commitment and passion to being active, community minded members and leaders within our community.

Each school within the City of Mitcham can apply for the funding to present as the ‘City of Mitcham Civic Participation and Leadership Award’ to one or two of their students annually (financial year).

<b>Guidelines for</b>	Civic Participation and Leadership Award
<b>Annual Budget</b>	\$2,600
<b>Individual Allocations</b>	\$100 is available annually to all schools (primary and secondary) located in the City of Mitcham looking to celebrate their students’ achievements. How each school would like to allocate these funds is their individual choice
<b>Funding Rounds</b>	Ongoing. There is no close date for applications. Each primary and secondary school located in the City of Mitcham are eligible to receive this grant each financial year
<b>Decision Makers</b>	Relative to each individual school
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	Students who have demonstrated commitment and passion to being active, community minded members and leaders within our community  There is the requirement that Council receives a bio on each award recipient, along with a photo to be used for marketing purposes. Please ensure you have permission from the family for this to occur prior to forwarding to Council
<b>Applications</b>	Applications must be received on Councils’ application form
<b>Assessment Process</b>	Relative to each individual school within the City of Mitcham’s own criteria
