Demonstration of Assessment Tool

- Read through the grant application taking note of the weight / percentage allocated to each question
- Input your scores and any comments / conditions / notes
- Save and return to Administration

New Timeline

- Grant Committee Members receive Grant Assessment Package 2 weeks after close date
- Grant Committee Members to assess each application using the grant scoring card and spreadsheet
- Return to Administration 2 weeks after receiving information
- Collated scores and information will be included in the Grants Committee agenda for final review
